A LOOK BACK AT... I-440+I-540

415



417- Two box culverts on the west side of Raleigh for Lane Construction on their I-440 project. We replaced and extended a portion of a box that had fallen off and we added a new culvert to the road on Capital Center Drive, connecting it back to Jones Franklin Rd. The Capital Center culvert flooded very easily and Pete had to devise a system to allow us to remove and install temporary pipes at a moment's notice.

412- Constructing the Easternmost portion of the I-540 work for Lane-Blythe JV. We worked closely with their team members to manage access to work as we constructed 9 box culverts. MCC was able to improve upon all of the water handling plans provided by LBJV to speed up construction and beat the budget.

414, 415- MCC battled with Flatiron Branch JV to maintain access and keep work available to our forces. We were able to push and keep the project progressing and through a full team effort and water handling revisions, we managed to finish our portion early and under budget.

Between these projects, we constructed 21 culverts in two years

416- Jose Tirado worked closely with ST Wooten managers to keep the project under budget and constantly progressing without gaps in availability. The careful coordination between ST Wooter and MCC allowed for the project overall to accelerate and solidified MCC's place as the premier box culvert contractor in the Carolinas.

399- A project that began as the final portion of the I-295 Fayetteville Outer Loop in which we constructed 8 box culverts. A change order was added to construct 2 more box culverts under I-95 to facilitate an interchange and handle flooding. MCC is scheduled to begin the final phase of construction in May of 2024.

440- MCC continues to push the general contractor, Webber, to make work available as we pursue the 4 box culverts on this project. We have completed the first phases of 3 out of 4 sites.

443- Working with Flatiron-UIG JV to replace 2 box culverts in Lumberton, NC with significantly larger boxes under I-95 to help reduce the chance of flooding, like was seen in Hurricane Matthew, in the future. We are expecting to begin this project later this year.
