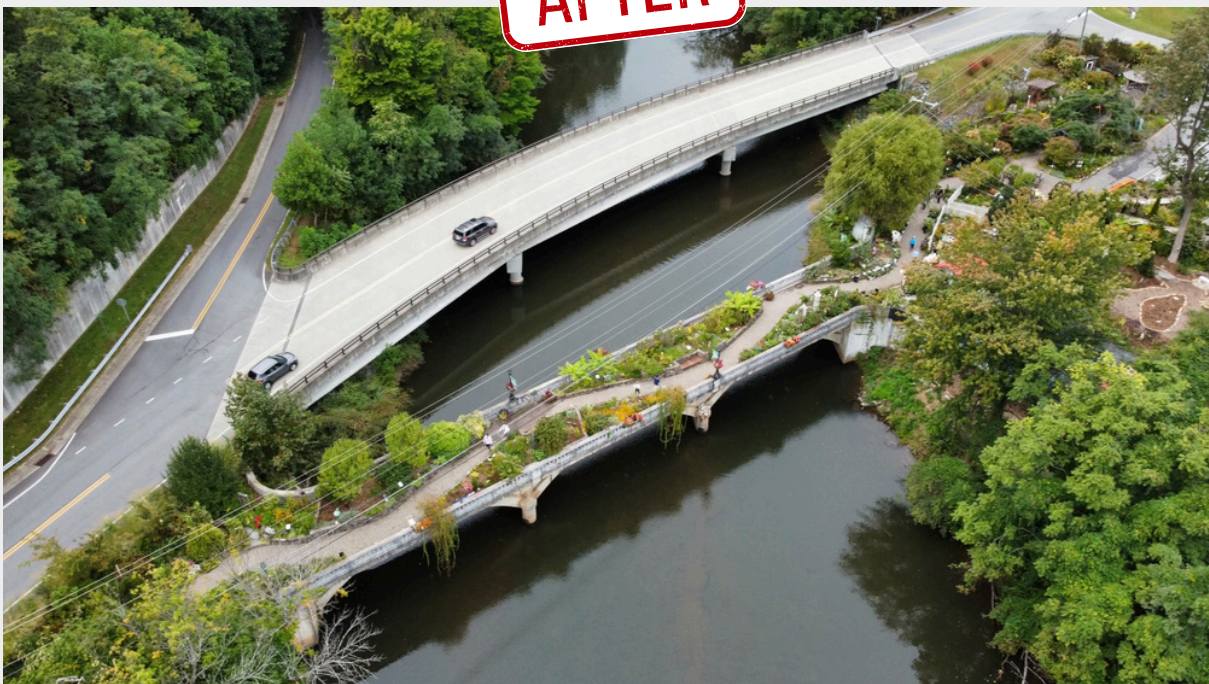
# A LOOK BACK AT... LAKE LURE

# AN UPDATE FROM OUR FRIENDS IN HAITI

MCC has been a long time sponsor of Lespwa Timoun- a health institution in Haiti with a primary focus on nutrition and a local orphanage that partners with the clinic. It has become increasingly more difficult over the past year for the clinic to get supplies and food due to the violence and unrest of Haiti's current political situation. There have also been concerns of safety for the children in the orphanage. Here is an update on the clinic's status from Dr. Donald Valdema:

**“When the bandits attacked last month the orphanage’s region, our hearts melted because we were scared for the safety of the children. They have already moved out three times. But, God protected them and helped them find a new place to stay. We had contacted the nurse who is in charge and she told us that they were running out of food and asked Lespwa Timoun staff if by any chance we could do something for them. That’s when we decided that we need to keep feeding the children before things get worse. As you can see in the pictures, the children as usual enjoy eating The Akamil (a mixture of corn and beans, rice and beans and/or wheat and beans that resembles instant oatmeal).”**
